ASCENSION LUTHERAN Colingwood Blvd. at Dorr St., is focused on persecution and martyrdom. Every 5 minutes, a Christian is martyred somewhere. Christians face persecution in 105 countries. More Christians have been martyred since 1900 than during the entire period from the time of Jesus up to 1900. Mark Berger, a member of Ascension Lutheran, participated with 25,000 others in a recent "All Lives Matter" March held in Birmingham, Alabama. The Police said that it was probably the largest march in Birmingham since the civil rights marches in 1963.
