INVITATION FROM PASTOR FOR A LENTEN FAST & PRAYER DAY

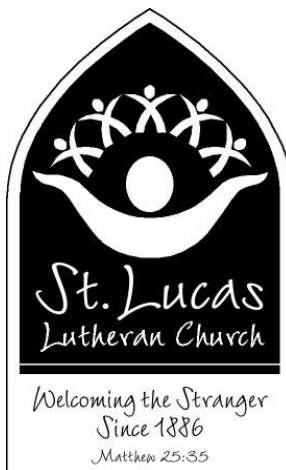
On Friday from 8am to 4pm. Here are
