The St Lucas Community Garden is growing! Thanks to Phil Chambers we have eight new raised beds, bringing our total up to 24 beds to grow in! Eight 7th and 8th Grade boys from St Joseph's school in Sylvania turned over and topped off the 16 old beds and began planting tomatoes, peppers, beans, and snap peas. Shawn and Erin from our CYF2G filled two of the new beds while Randy Hyter, volunteers from Cindy's Corner, and others filled the other six new beds. We have the garden ready for planting – all we need are the gardeners. If you want to grow good things to eat for yourself, your family, the Cindy's Corner lunch program, or all three, have we got a deal for you! We have Twenty-four 4 ft by 8 ft beds available to plant. We need growers who want to farm them, helpers to help weed and water them, and hungry mouths to eat the good things they grow. You can sign up for a half (4' X 4') or full (4' X 8') bed.
