NOTICE OF SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

Pursuant to the St. Lucas By-Laws and Constitution, St. Lucas church Council on June 14th, 2016 called a special congregational meeting for Sunday July 10th, 2016 at 10:00 AM. The meeting will take place in the main sanctuary for the purpose of discussing & and voting on the following proposed expenditures:

- 1) That up to \$9,700.00 be expended from the St. Lucas Organ Fund in payment of necessary repairs related to the organ swell plein jeu and releathering of 5 wind reservoirs. Work to be performed by the Renaissance Pipe Organ Co.;
- 2) That up to \$6,100.00 be expended from the St. Lucas Capital Improvement Fund for necessary elevator repairs. Work to be performed by Vertical Mobility of Toledo, LLC.

While these expenditures and repairs have been recommended by Council, they may not proceed without a Congregational vote with a necessary quorum. Brief presentations will take place at this meeting. Your attendance is necessary and essential.

The St Lucas Community Garden is filling up! We have ten beds still available for planting – all we need are the gardeners. If you want to grow good things to eat for yourself, your family, the Cindy's Corner lunch program, or all three, we have the spot where you can do it! Request a half bed (4' X 4') or a full (4' X 8') bed. Sign up forms are available from the Church Office, the information table after Sunday Services, at Cindy's Corner lunch program, or from Garden Coordinator, Michael Biscay – mbiscay@hotmail.com or 419-244-2243. We have seeds and even some plants started that will get your plot going quickly. Other ways you can help in and around the garden: *We have free compost and mulch

available to us if we can get a pickup or other truck to go get it. *Do you have a truck we could use, borrow, or otherwise utilize for an afternoon? *We could use several more old tires for planting climbing vines (Squash, Melons, Cucumbers, etc) along the garden fence. *If you have one or two old tires around, please leave them at the garden edge and we'll get them working. Six tires, maximum please – we don't want to turn into a tire dump.

We will be offering a short WORKSHOP on vertical gardening soon – how to grow many plants in limited space. Save 6 or 8 2-liter pop bottles with caps and indicate your interest on the back of your "I Worship Today" card. See you in the Garden!

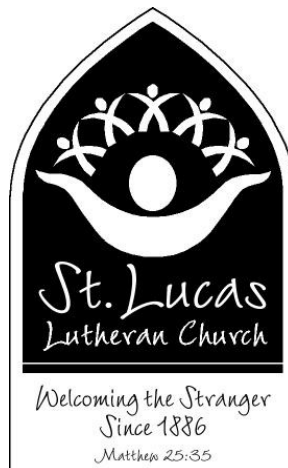
