CHOIR REHEARSAL CANCELLED FOR THIS WEEK There will be no choir rehearsal this wee, Thursday Oct 13th.

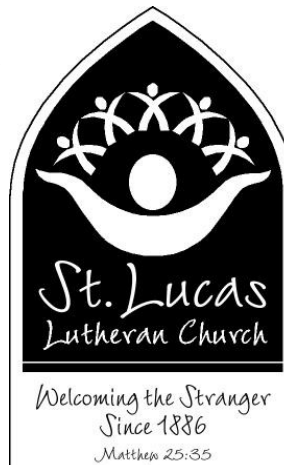
