Sermon Series: Spiritual Locations and Dislocations

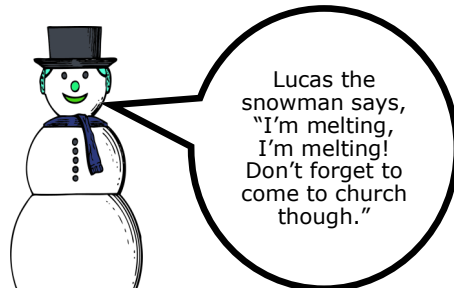
March 8 **Dislocation: From Eden Genesis 2:15-17, 3:1-7**
