

The Spring has sprung, the Fall has fell, The Winter is coming, and it's colder than ... it was last year at this time.


#### The mathematics of leaves and mulch

At the Consecration Celebration dinner a couple of St. Lucas members asked me if we REALLY still needed leaves for the garden. Here's why I said "YES!!"

One of our final tasks in this fall's garden is preparing it for winter. We would like to top dress each bed with the compost and alpaca poop we have waiting on site, then tuck them in with a blanket of leaves 4 inches deep or so. We have 24 beds, 4 ft. X 8 ft. or 768 square feet of garden beds. 4 inches of leaves is 1/3 of a foot, or 253.4 cubic feet of leaves. A 30 gallon trash bag holds approximately 4 cubic feet of leaves, so simple math tells us that we need 65 to 70 bags of leaves to do the job.

WE NEED YOUR LEAVES! When you give your lawn that final mowing, when you sweep up Nature's bountiful bonus of leaves, please bag them and bring them to church with you. Leave them by the parking lot and we'll mulch them up to give the garden a cozy blanket that will have it ready for next spring's planting. We'll top-dress the beds with compost and alpaca poop, top it off with a
