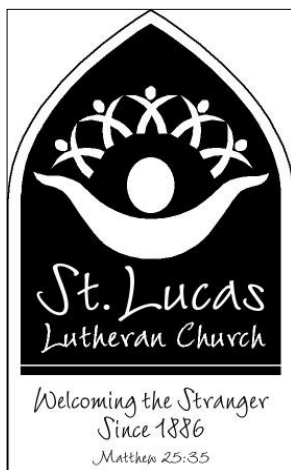
SPRING RUMMAGE SALE will be May 3, 4 & 5.
