June 23 South Branch Library - Focus: Social Services, Churches

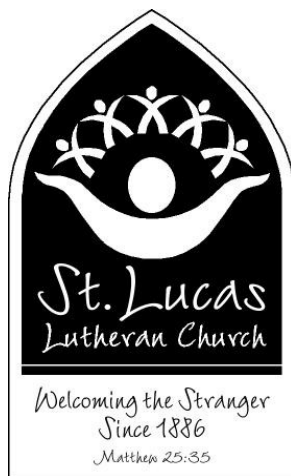
June 25 Believe Center - Focus: Residents

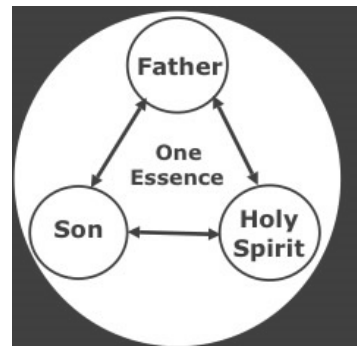
REMINDER: EARLY SERVICE TIME CHANGE
