The St Lucas Community Garden has grown! All 24 beds have been planted, the beans are climbing their supports into the sunshine, the first batch of radishes is producing delicious seedpods and all manner of other good things are burgeoning. Stroll through the garden and see what's growing on. **Some ways you can help in and around the garden:**

- ◆ We have free compost and mulch available to us if we can get a pickup or other truck to go get it. Do you have a truck we could use, borrow, or otherwise utilize for an afternoon?
- ◆ We have gathered four old tires for planting climbing vines (Squash, Melons, Cucumbers, etc) along the garden fence. We could still use a few more. Please leave them at the garden edge and we'll get them working. Six more tires, maximum please – we don't want to turn into a tire dump.
- ◆ We will be offering a short workshop on vertical gardening Thursday July 21st from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. Learn how to grow many plants in limited space. Bring 6 or 8 2-liter pop bottles with caps, some cleaned 1 or 2 lb. cottage cheese containers or something similar. See you in the Garden! Pull a weed or two, if you recognize them – Thanks!
