**GRADUATING?** Please let us know on the back of your "I'm Here Today" card or call the office. We will bless our graduates the weekend of June 11 all three services.

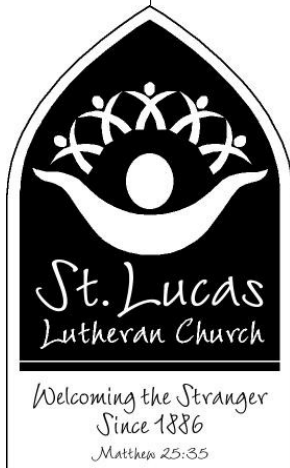
