### USE OF CELL PHONES/TABLETS ENCOURAGED DURING WORSHIP

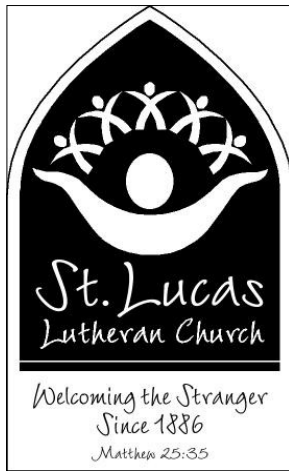

## St Lucas Garden News

June is over and the garden is green and lush. A group of 14 students, in town for a 2-week medical school orientation, worked on the garden and the hugel mound on Saturday, June 16<sup>th</sup>. They spread out the wood chips, added topsoil and planted squash and melons on our Frank Street lot. They also finished planting the last few beds in the main garden and put in some raspberry plants. Many thanks to the U of Toledo, the students, to Tiffany Akeman and Dave Pearson for arrang-

ing their work project, and to Randy Hyter who helped me direct their efforts.

Our strawberries are down to a few shy berries, huddled under the leaves. After they take a brief rest, they will start putting out the runners that will produce next year's berries. We may have some extra plants available for your home garden if they're as prolific as they were last year. Let me know if you'd like a few.

We have tomatoes, peppers, cucumbers, zucchini, eggplant, okra, green beans, carrots, beets, summer squash, parsley, basil, and thyme growing in our beds. There's room for a plant or two more if you think of something we've missed. Oh, there are raspberries growing in some of our garden-side tires and a sunflower or two that you might have noticed. Our pollinator bed has some gorgeous poppies, bachelor's buttons and other flowers to attract the good insects and to gladden the hearts of our garden visitors.
