ST LUCAS GARDEN NEWS

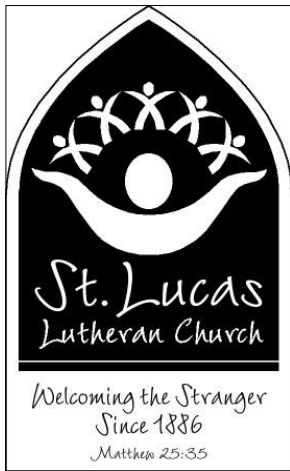

Our neighbors have taken home two of our cabbages already – although they could have used a couple more weeks to grow and mature – our bell peppers are getting near to harvesting size, and our tomatoes are showing apple sized fruits – still green, though. The green bean vines have outgrown their 8 foot high supports and will be blooming and beaming soon. While we're on the subject of tomatoes, if you happen to have any tomato cages or towers that are currently unoccupied, we have a dozen tomato plants that need some gentle support and guidance – they have a tendency to ramble all over the garden without that.
