**NEW DATE FOR THIS MONTH'S W.E.L.C.A.** Bible study and business meeting is Feb. 19 at 9:30 and 10:30.

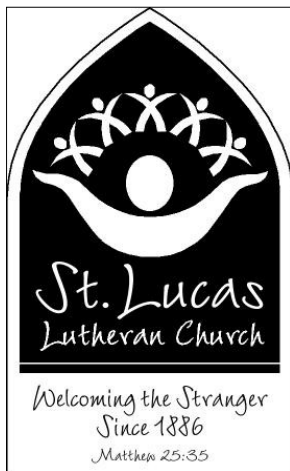
