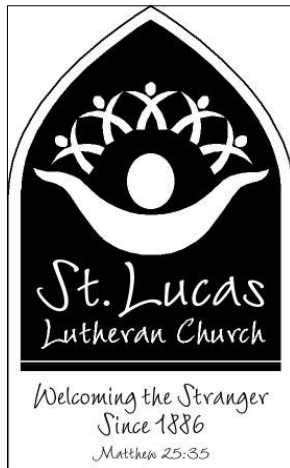
STEWARDSHIP MONTHLY MESSAGE READERS FOR 4PM & 8:30 SERVICES See sign up sheets.

"Being from Venezuela, I feel I have to do this for my native country and my people," said founder and president Linda Parra. "Seeing the situation there, it's heartbreaking. My family is still there. I had to do something."
