Hi Pastor,

I wanted to let you know that I recently became a missionary with First Love International. I am currently traveling raising funds and promoting the ministry of Threads of Hope, a ministry that brings help and hope to families at risk of human trafficking in the Philippines. I have already been on the road for three weeks. In that time God has not only used us to promote the ministry, but unexpectedly used us to encourage and impact some of the lives around us. In Atlanta we met a victim of human trafficking in the states. She was so encouraged by what we were doing she shared her story. We prayed together, and were later able to share Christ love with her son. That night her son accepted Christ as his savior. I'm really excited to see what else God has in store for us this summer.
