HISTORIC TRINITY DETROIT TRIP The pastors of Glenwood, St. Paul's downtown and St. Lucas are arranging a bus trip to Historic Trinity Lutheran church in Detroit on Nov. 16. This trip will be for both fun and education. The organist at Historic Trinity is a friend of Pastor Billmeier and will give us a tour of this beautiful neo-gothic church already decorated beautifully for the Christmas holidays. Organist Karl has also arranged for Pastor David Eberhard of Historic Trinity to tell us about the Cathedral Ministry model that he conceived to revitalize Historic Trinity, which was dangerously close to closing back in the 1980s, but is now built up to over 1,000 members. We invite all St. Lucas leaders of any kind to participate in this trip. St. Lucas had taken trips to Historic Trinity back in the '90s as part of our own remaking of ourselves for mission and have adopted many of the Cathedral Ministry concepts. We will leave by bus at 12:30 (after the late church service) on the 16th from Glenwood's parking lot to arrive at Historic Trinity by 1:30 or 2:00. Glenwood will supply box lunches for the bus trip. Please reserve on the back of your "I'm Here Today" card with "bus trip." After the tour and talk from Pastor Eberhard we will have dinner in Greektown before we return. We need your reservation by Oct. 12 to make sure we can fill the bus. A \$10 donation per person will cover the cost of the bus and each attendee will have to pay for their own dinner in Greektown.
