If you are willing to take this spiritual challenge, commit to fasting and prayer every Friday from 8am-4pm from now until year's end. Let the intention of your fast and prayer be that God will purify our mission to make the good news of Jesus our #1 priority, and that we as a faith community will major in evangelism and stewardship, so that deficits will no longer be a concern around here. Your fast may be one of giving up one food during those hours, drinking liquids only or giving up something else, while also through the day remembering your intention in prayer.
